The Agricultural Group Compensation Self Insurer Fund (AG Comp) is an innovative alternative market for workers' compensation coverage that has been in existence since September 1, 1992. Ag Comp operates within the guidelines of the Arkansas Workers' Compensation Law and is regulated by the Arkansas Workers' Compensation Commission.

The purpose of the fund is to help employers by:

- ✓ Limiting their liability risks
- ✓ Reducing the cost to cover employee injuries
- ✓ Providing needed assistance to their injured employees
- ✓ Keeping agriculture related businesses in business



## Why do you need Ag Comp?
